FREE SAFEGUARDING TRAINING ONLINE

The National Catholic Safeguarding Commission (NCSC) has worked with EduCare to provide an online, interactive E-Learning safeguarding course which is now available to all in the Catholic Church. If you have a role (voluntary or paid) working with children/adults at risk, or have an interest in safeguarding, the online training is a great opportunity to learn how to better protect children/ adults at risk in your care and community. Some of the modules available include: Child Protection, Child Exploitation & Online Safety, and Adult Safeguarding.

What do I need to do to access this training resource?

Firstly email office@sgo-rcdsouthwark.org to register your interest.

This email should contain:

Your name and email address;
The name of your parish/order/congregation; and
Your parish role (eg priest, youth worker, teacher, parent, grandparent, guardian, catechist, Minister of the Eucharist or any other).

On receipt of your email, the safeguarding administrator will register your email address with EduCare. You will then receive a Welcome Email from EduCare where you will set your password.
