After a considerable amount of preparatory work, we have been approved by the Home Office. We are now equipping a house in Wallington to welcome a Syrian family comprising parents and three young girls under 5, who are at present in the Middle East. Thanks to the generous response of parishes and individuals we will be able to purchase many of the basic necessities. However if any parishioners are planning to dispose of or upgrade certain household goods, baby equipment, and toys or simple books for young children, we would be glad of offers of items in very good condition.
