PERSECUTED CHRISTIANS APPEAL Mike Quigley writes: Thanks to the usual kindness of St Margaret's in contributing earlier in the year, much needed items, including bedding and 2 kg of Calpol, were sent to persecuted Christians including children who fled Syria and other parts of the Middle East. These poor souls arrive at the 'House of Prayer' in Athens which includes Inter-alia, a drop-in café, which has requested donations of boxes of English Breakfast or Earl Grey tea bags and packets of biscuits, such as Oat Crunch, Rich Tea or similar. Also required are sanitary towels for the women. Apparently, such items are not readily available or affordable locally. Please can we, once again, ask our generous Parishioners to donate the above mentioned, before the last week in October when they need to be despatched. A receptacle will be placed in the meeting area for your gifts.

PRISONERS' SUNDAY is celebrated on 14th October and will mark the beginning of Prisons Week. The Prison Advice and Care Trust (PACT), is the only national Catholic charity dedicated to engaging with the issues that can arise from being in prison or the effect that it can have on loved ones. If you are interested in supporting the work of PACT, whether through volunteering (such as befriending) or fundraising, please see poster on the noticeboard and the accompanying literature. There are also envelopes in the foyer for any donations you might wish to make.

A DAY WITH MARY is a day of instruction, devotion and intercession, based on the message given at Fatima in 1917. If you wish to participate, there is a choice of two dates and venues; on 20th October at Westminster Cathedral and 27 October at Our Lady and St Peter, Wimbledon Common. RED BOX COLLECTION will be collected at all masses on 20th and 21st October. The Association for the Propagation of the Faith (APF) assists every one of the Catholic Church's 1,069 mission dioceses through the Mill Hill Missionery Society - the only major missionary society formed in England. Mill Hill missionaries go to the most remote places on earth to show the love of Christ to those in need, both spiritually and materially. In England and Wales, funds are collected through the famous Red Boxes in over 200,000 homes. They have helped raise millions of pounds for the missionary Church. It was founded in 1822 by Pauline-Marie Jaricot, a young woman in Lyons, France. She persuaded local working people to give a farthing a week in support of overseas mission. A century later, the organisation was established in almost every country in the world. Pope Pius XI made it the official mission-funding society for the Catholic Church.

One beneficiary are ethnic groups in Ethiopia such as the Menja who are despised, feared and rejected by the majority. The Little Sisters of Jesus reach out by helping Menja families grow and sell coffee for food, aiding pregnant women deliver their babies safely and educatingtheir youth.
