THE VATICAN announced on 10th June that "The Holy Father has accepted the resignation from the pastoral care of the diocese of Southwark, England, by Archbishop Peter Smith." At the same time it was announced that Bishop John Wilson, Auxiliary Bishop in Westminster, has been appointed as the Archbishop of Southwark. Archbishop-Elect John will take possession of the Diocese during an Installation Mass to take place at 12 noon on Thursday 25th July, the Feast of the Apostle St James. Further details concerning arrangements will follow in due course.

NEW PILGRIM PATH (www.newpilgrimpath.ie) is inspired by Pope Francis's enthusiasm for the internet. He urges Christians to "walk the streets of the digital highways in order to dialogue with people today and to help them encounter Christ". Each week they feature a website which may be of interest to fellow Christians. Pray As You Go is a **daily prayer session** based on Ignatian spirituality, designed to go with you whether on the move, or at your computer. You can download the app for your phone, or listen on your desktop or laptop. A new prayer session is produced every day of the working week and one session for the weekend. It is not a 'Thought for the Day', a sermon or a bible-study, but rather a framework for your own prayer. Lasting between ten and thirteen minutes, it combines music, scripture and some questions for reflection. It can be accessed via the website.
